
INFORMATION CLAUSE
regarding the processing of personal data in connection with KSeF

1. The controller of your personal data is VINTVIEW Sp. z o.o., Tax Identification Number (NIP): 5130302015. Contact details of the Controller: Kolberga 17E/1, 32-085 Tomaszowice, Poland, e-mail: lukasz@ventview.com
2. The Controller has appointed / has not appointed* a Data Protection Officer (DPO). In matters related to personal data protection, please contact us in writing at the Controller's postal address with the note "DPO" or via e-mail: lukasz@ventview.com
3. Personal data will be processed pursuant to Article 6(1)(c) of the General Data Protection Regulation (hereinafter: GDPR) – fulfillment of the Controller's legal obligation resulting from the provisions of the Act of 11 March 2004 on Goods and Services Tax and the Regulation of the Minister of Finance of 27 December 2021 regarding the use of the National e-Invoicing System, for the purpose of fulfilling the legal obligation incumbent upon the Controller involving activities performed in the IT system of the Head of the National Revenue Administration, i.e., the National e-Invoicing System (hereinafter: KSeF), consisting of issuing and receiving structured invoices.
4. Recipients of your personal data may include:
 1. entities with whom the Controller has concluded a personal data processing agreement and which provide services supporting the Controller's business operations;
 2. authorities and other entities, including public entities, authorized under generally applicable laws to obtain your personal data, as well as the Head of the National Revenue Administration in connection with issuing invoices through KSeF.
5. Personal data processed in relation to issuing and receiving invoices will be made available exclusively to entities authorized to process such data under applicable laws, including: police authorities, courts, public prosecutors, court bailiffs, and other enforcement authorities.
6. The Controller does not intend to transfer your personal data to a third country or an international organization. Personal data will also not be used for purposes other than those for which they were originally collected.
7. Your personal data will be stored until the expiration of the tax liability limitation period. Personal data contained in invoices will additionally be stored in KSeF for a period of 10 years from the date of issuance.
8. You have the right to access your personal data, request rectification, deletion in cases provided for by law, and submit a request for restriction of the processing of personal data.
9. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, namely the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (UODO) with its registered office in Warsaw, Poland.
10. Providing your personal data is a statutory obligation. Failure to provide the required data will result in the inability to issue an invoice and consequently the termination of cooperation.
11. No automated decision-making, including profiling, will be applied to your personal data.
